WELCOME TO REPROMED

Medication costs for IVF treatment varies and it is peronalised to your individual situation. The typical average cost of medications for one IVF cycle is approximately \$3,815-\$6,040. Please note that medication costs are priced separately from treatment costs. This is because everyone has a unique requirement based on many factors and ensures you don't pay for more than you need. Based on the below, your fertility doctor will recommend the medication required by advising the dosage and length of time you are required to take each item.

Please note, once medication has left Repromed, we cannot take it back or provide a refund.
