



Clinic egg donor overview

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- The donor coordinator emails potential donor information about being a donor.
- Donor confirms they want to proceed.
- Online registration process completed.
- The donor emails two forms of ID to the donor coordinator (driver licence and passport preferred).
- AMH level and first screening bloods (paid for by Repromed).
- Three-month quarantine period starts.
- Contract of care and health questionnaires are completed.
- Donor contacts the administration team on 09 524 1232 to arrange a doctor consultation.
- Clinician consultation (40 mins).
- First donor implications counselling (60 mins with partner/spouse if applicable).
 - Donor completes and returns non-identifying profile.
- Second screening bloods and genetic testing (mouth swab).
- Second donor counselling (60 mins with partner/spouse if applicable).
 - Donor non-identifying profile opens for intended parents to view.
 - Donor (partner/spouse if applicable) completes and returns the consent forms.
- Three-month quarantine bloods for donor and partner/spouse bloods (if applicable).
- Nurse orientation and drug teach, treatment plan review and treatment dates confirmed (40-50 mins).
- Call nurses on day 1 of cycle.
- Egg collection approx 30 mins and up to two hours recovery.

1st blood test:

- AMH
- Hep B/C
- HIV
- Syphilis
- Thyroid
- Rubella/Measles
- Blood group

2nd blood/urine test:

- CMV IgG/IgM (cytomegalovirus)
- HTLV I & II
- Karyotype
- Full blood count
- Chlamydia/Gonorrhoea (urine)

VCGS genetic test: (mouth swab)

- Three of the most common severe genetic conditions
- Cystic Fibrosis
 - Fragile X
 - Spinal Muscular Atrophy

3rd blood test:

- Hep B/C
- HIV
- Syphilis



****Please note: if you have a partner/spouse, they will also be required to have a single blood test for Hep B/C, HIV, and syphilis.**
